Facility Fees

Iredell Surgical Center fees cover only the use of the facility, and do not include pathology, surgeon, anesthesiologist or certified nurse anesthetist fees. You will be billed separately for these fees.

Collections and Payment Policy

- Co-pays and deductibles will be due on the day of your surgery.
- For patients with no insurance coverage, all fees will be due in advance.
- We're happy to accept cash, cashier's checks, credit cards and personal checks with valid identification.

Please let us know prior to your surgery if you need help making special financial arrangements; we're happy to discuss alternative payment methods with you.

Medicare

Iredell Surgical Center welcomes Medicare beneficiaries for treatment; we are Medicare certified and comply with all specified physical plant, staffing, safety and governance standards.

"Facility fees apply for approved services at an Ambulatory Surgery Center (a facility where surgical procedures are performed and the patient is released the same day). This means that you will pay co-insurance, and Part B deductible."
